

New equipment elevates KZN dairy's production

LEADING KZN milk producer Dairy Day recently acquired six Crown 3-wheel electric forklifts with double batteries to cater for double shifts and two Crown powered pallet trucks, also with double batteries.

The equipment was supplied by Goscor Lift Truck Company and is being used at Dairy Day's new 15 000m² processing facility in Howick. The plant can process up to 600 000 litres of fresh milk per day and, in addition to milk, it is also well-known for its maas, yoghurt, cream, fresh juice, dairy blends, butter and powdered milk.

"Taking into account the efficiency and durability of the machines and the quality of Goscor's service and support we are sure that over the lifetime of the machines we will get the best possible return on investment," he said.
